

ICC Solutions USB Licence Keys

Overview

The ICC USB Licence key is a new method of controlling ICCSimTMat licences that is much more efficient than the previous process of sending and receiving activation/removal codes from the ICC Solutions Helpdesk.

Using a piece of hardware containing the licence file you are able to bypass the process of activating the software as the required information is held on the secure USB licence key. When it is inserted into the chosen PC you can access your installed ICCSimTMat suites from a single program also eliminating the need for multiple versions of ICCSimTMat being installed on the PC.

Using the USB Licence Key

Functionality

The USB licence key is used with the **ICCSimTMat Base** tool. From TMat Base you can access all your installed suites, so for example the ADVT test suite would be accessed in the same tool as the Mastercard MTIP suite.

When TMat Base is run with the USB Key attached the user is presented with a list of available suites. You select your suite and can then begin running tests.

When you run TMat Base without the USB key attached you can still access all installed suites to review logs, export results and generate reports however you cannot run tests.

New Licences

New licences will be controlled using USB Licence Keys; each USB can have any combination of suite licences so for example one USB key could have MTIP, ADVT and Interac meaning these three test suites are available on a PC with that USB key attached. This key can then be inserted into a different PC giving access to those suites on that PC.

Existing Licences

Customers with existing software licences have two options:

- Transfer software licences to a USB key/keys Current licences that have been activated using activation codes can be removed using a deactivation code provided from ICC Solutions. ICC then provides a configuration file that will transfer that licence/licences to a USB key.
- Keep a combination of soft licences and USB Key licences Any existing licences on the PC can still be access
 through TMat Base. A list of software licences will be presented with the list of USB licences on start-up of TMat Base.
